

Pedestrian Bridges over Route 130 Concept Development Study

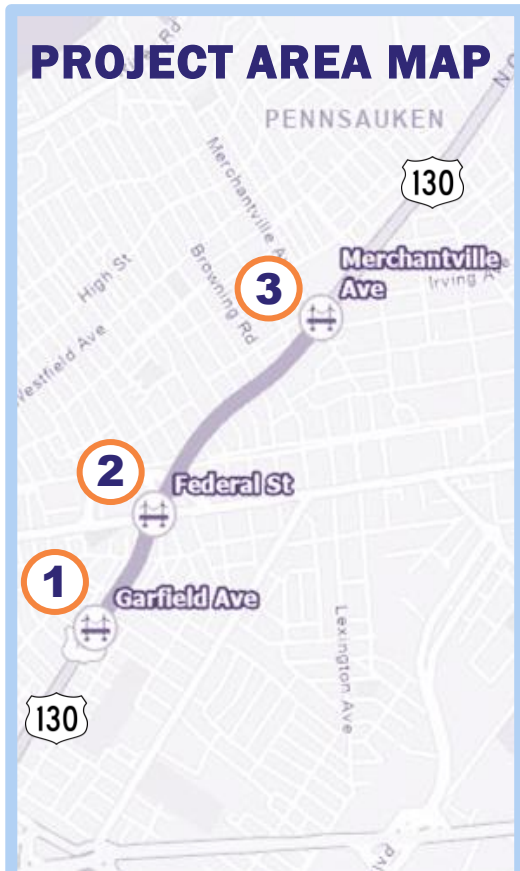
Pennsauken Township, Camden County



The New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) is developing a Limited Scope Concept Development Study for Pedestrian Bridges over Route 130 at Garfield Avenue, Federal Street, and Merchantville Avenue to enhance pedestrian safety and accessibility and extend service life.

Why is this Study Important?

- *The three bridges in the study area are over 50 years old*
- *Improvements are required to remain structurally sound*
- *Pedestrian bridges play a critical role in providing safe access across the highway and need to **comply with accessibility standards**.*



The study is being conducted by HNTB Corporation, a consultant on behalf of NJDOT, to complete the technical study and conduct outreach activities, and is expected to be completed in early 2027.
